## What is the **Green Living Areas Mission**?

Our Mission aims to improve the lives of Mediterranean citizens by promoting the development of green living areas. As part of the Interreg Euro-MED Programme, the Mission undertakes projects that **bring local communities to life with green development** at their epicentre, **reducing negative climate impacts** on the region's ecosystems, and **enhancing climate resilience**.





# What is the **Green Living Areas Mission**?

The Mission is jointly managed by **two key projects** working on two different aspects:



The **Thematic Community project** (Community4LivingAreas) aims to **build a community among thematic projects** and facilitate resource transfers to stakeholders, focusing on technical and strategic content.



The **Institutional Dialogue project** (Dialogue4LivingAreas) aims to amplify the **transfer of policies by fostering focused dialogue** among policymakers and their stakeholders, focusing on policy improvement and transformation.

## Community4LivingAreas focus

areas

Territories are a complex and living ecosystem, connected to each other

C4LA wants to encourage sustainable development and an integrated vision of the territories' adaptation to climate change by supporting the **transition** towards a **greener environment**.

A territory in transition must learn to manage relationships of all kinds, as opposed to the "silo politics".

Moving from the idea of "local management", which focuses on the administrative activity of local authorities, to "territorial governance", which is part of a **multi-level governance** system that goes **from local**







A Green Living Area is the effective integration of physical, digital, and human systems in an area, supported by sustainable, continuously improved policies through institutional dialogue, to deliver a sustainable, equitable, prosperous, and inclusive future, and quality of life for its citizens.







# What is a Green Living Area?

It is composed of the following characteristics:

#### Green Living Energy Systems

A sustainable transition in the Mediterranean also requires a transition to renewable energy sources. We investigate how to make the energy transition safe, equitable, and most importantly, green.



#### Green Living Buildings

A sustainable transition in the Mediterranean also requires a transition to renewable energy sources. We investigate how to make the energy transition safe, equitable, and most importantly, green.

#### Green Living Mobility Systems

Enabling a modal shift requires sustainable traveling options. We explore how to deliver sustainable mobility services designed to meet citizen needs, providing options for different user profiles and promoting the green development of wellconnected transport infrastructure.

The IDP works on the improvement of the quality of life in Mediterranean territories by advocating for sustainable development and energy transition of living areas, integrating a comprehensive territorial vision that minimizes environmental impact while fostering prosperous, and inclusive communities. 


