CIVIL SOCIETY ORGANIZATIONS AND THE GREEN TRANSITION IN THE SOUTHERN NEIGHBOURHOOD:

Civil society organizations in southern Mediterranean countries often lack essential adaptive management capacity to become effective agents for coordinated and longterm development processes.

The new Agenda for the Mediterranean offers some opportunities for new partnerships on strategic priorities of green and digital transition and is based on the conviction that sustainable prosperity and resilience can only be built in strong partnership across the Mediterranean.





MAIN CHALLENGES FACING SOUTHERN COUNTRIES IN THE MEDITERRANEAN REGION RELATED TO NATURAL HERITAGE

- Unsustainable use of
 natural resources
- *Climate change increasing challenges, which affect water, food, energy and ecosystems.*
- **Disaster risks** (desertification, droughts, heat waves, etc..)
- Lack of **awareness** raising

- Environmental degradation and loss of biodiversity
- **Pollution** of land, water and air
- Unsustainable consumption and production patterns
- Unsustainable solid wastes
 management and marine
 litter

AREAS OF POTENTIAL INTERVENTIONS TO ENHANCE NORTH-SOUTH COOPERATION

- Support to biodiversity education, awareness and capacity development.
- Support the conservation and sustainable management of natural resources
- Support to have good governance and accountability mechanisms.
- Support the conservation and sustainable use of biodiversity and ecosystems, including forests, oceans, coastal areas, river basins and other ecosystems.

- Support green, circular, and blue economies
- Sustainable production and consumption.
- Support Digital transformation, research and innovation
- Resource efficiency, including water and waste management.
