



Focus areas

Thematic clustering of TPs



Marine resources (6 TPs)

Includes economic activities related to oceans, seas, and coasts, such as aquaculture, fisheries, blue biotechnologies, and marine renewable energy



Industrial transition (7 TPs)

Supports the EU's goal of climate neutrality and digital advancement, focusing on innovation and economic adaptability



Agri-food systems (4 TPs)

Encompasses all activities from farm to table, including the entire food value chain



Resource valorization (6 TPs)

Focuses on converting waste products from economic activities into useful materials, following the circular economy's 10 Rs model














Our Work




Policy impact

Scan4Messages

Encourages members to cocreate collective, coherent, and impactful policy messages, while also addressing how these messages are delivered across the region.









ACT

TIP Labs

— Transformative Innovation Policy Labs

Facilitated spaces in which multiple territorial actors meet to address collectively place-based complex challenges with a transformative innovation and systemic approach

First generation of 9 TIP Labs managed by D4I partners to address sustainability challenges that are local and place-based, but relevant at regional and Mediterranean level

Second generation of TIP Labs: Open call for expression of interest in 2027 to replicate the Labs in other territories with free technical support from the Mission

Increased adoption of ISE Mission solutions, amplifying the impact of Interreg Euro Med program






