Institutional Policy Dialogue process:

Services of the Policy Hub

- Privileged exchanges among peers and with key Euro-Mediterranean stakeholders;
- Access to information allowing you to capitalise on policy-oriented best practices;
- Participation at European-level events;
- Lobbying and Advocacy;
- Other actions: more tailored to your specific needs.
- > Access to a dedicated platform: a collaborative tool for policy solutions, to be launched in October 2025!







Institutional Policy Dialogue process: Second Institutional Policy Dialogue

- In Brussels, on 15 October (afternoon), and 16 October (all day).
- Objectives: Exchanges on Policy Champions from Thematic Projects and other mature policy instruments, through co-development sessions, with the participation of Core Group members.






