Project results can ...

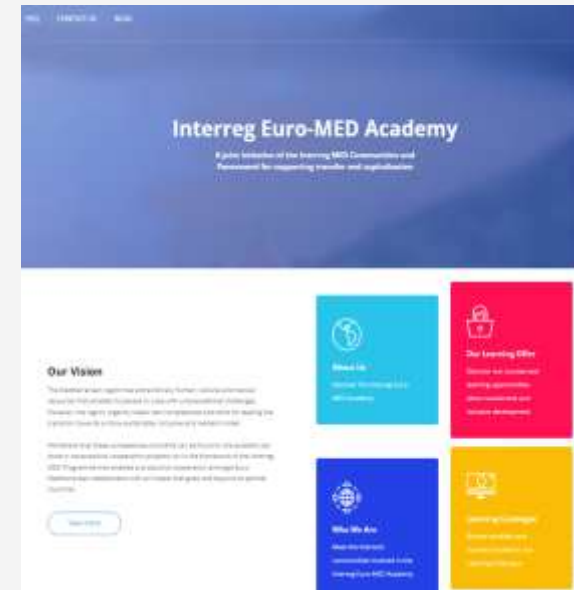
- remain fragmented across projects and platforms

Building on previous experience

The previous Programme period provided a first testing ground for the Academy.

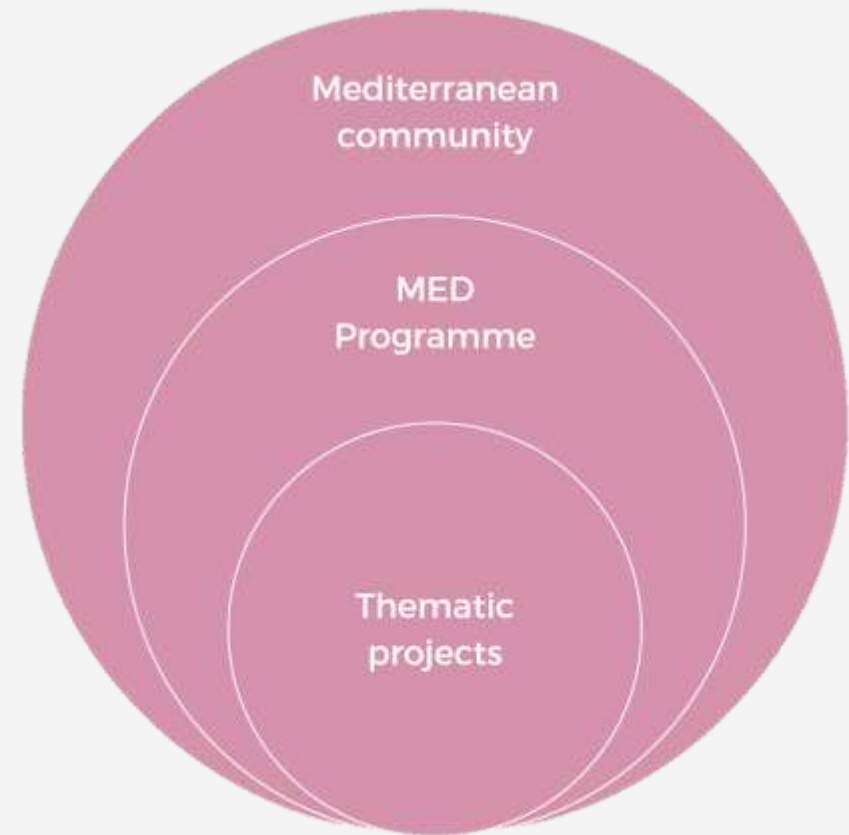
We do not start from scratch: pilot edition initiated and coordinated by UNIMED in 2021-2022

- **81 organisations** engaged in the conception, production and delivery of the training courses
- **131 experts** involved as coordinators, trainers and guest speakers
- **9 learning programs** delivered
- **266 video lessons** produced
- **1.145 users** registered



From individual projects to a wider Mediterranean community

- The ambition is to extend the reach and lifetime of project knowledge
- A shared space where project results can remain visible, accessible, and relevant over time.

PRACTICE-BASED

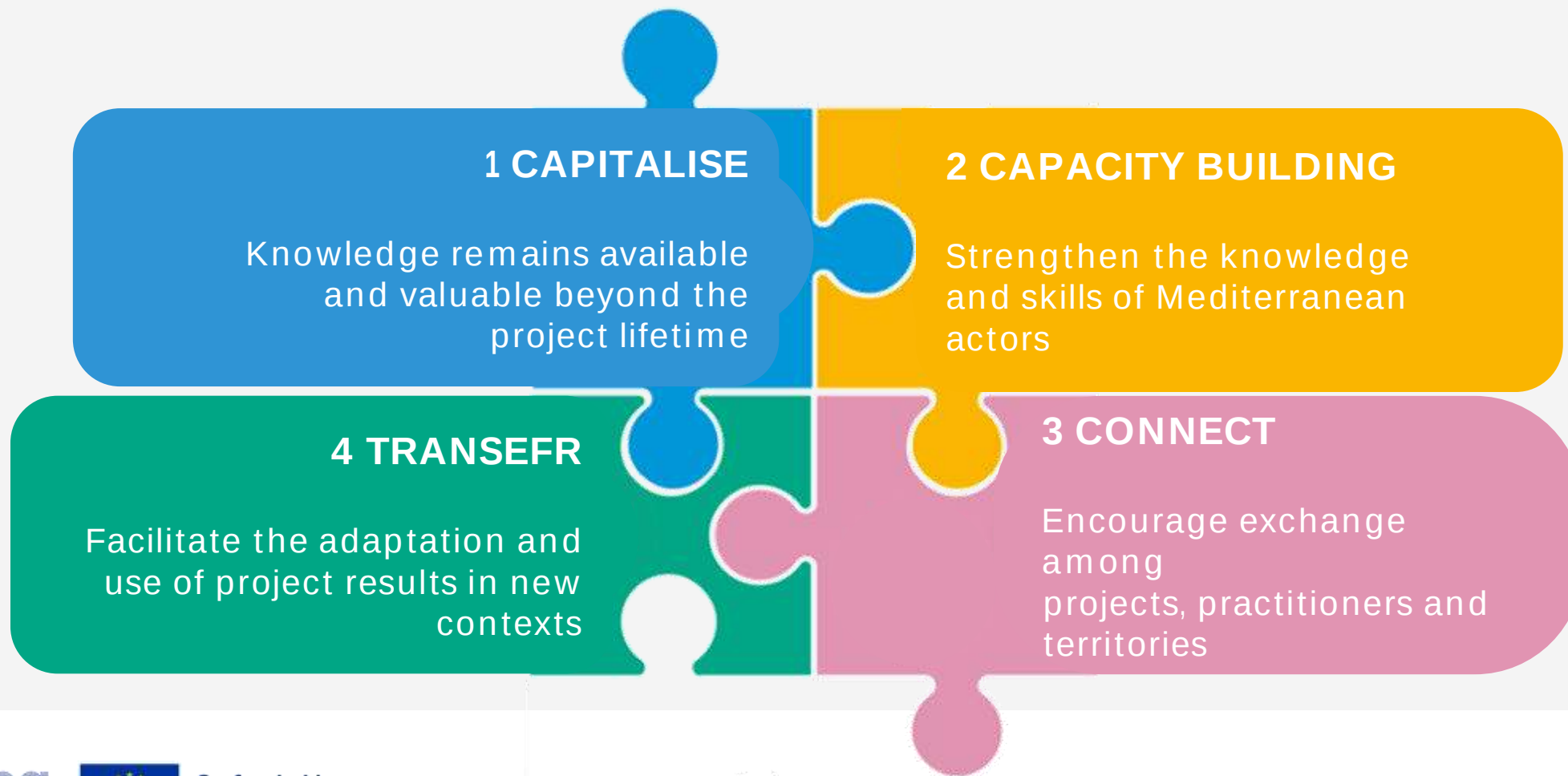
Learning should build on methods, tools, and solutions developed by thematic projects.
