A green living area is a territorial holistic approach to reducing the negative climate impact of urban activities and enhancing climate resilience for an improved citizens life quality.

- Increased **capacity of public authorities** in effective **planning and financing** for climate change adaptation and energy transition

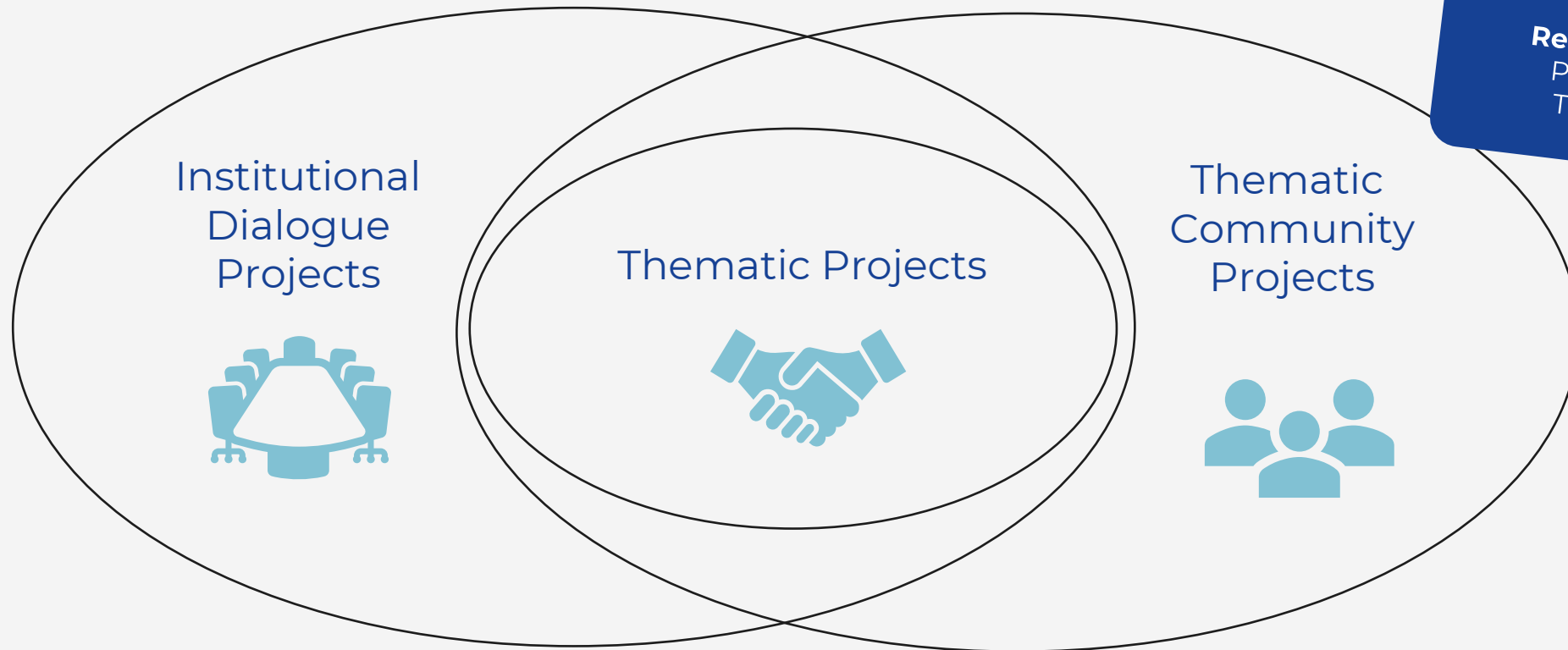
