

Promoting Green Living Areas

A green living area is a territorial holistic approach to reducing the negative climate impact of urban activities and enhancing climate resilience for an improved citizens life quality.

Project focus under Mission Green Living Areas

Securing and improving environmental life quality through:



Promoting climate change adaptation and disaster risk prevention, resilience, taking into account eco-systembased approaches

- Increased capacity of public authorities in effective planning and financing for climate change adaptation and energy transition
- Holistic and transdisciplinary approach to green living areas issues.
- **Citizens engagement** for more sustainable living areas

Focus on urban regeneration: heat island effects, water cycle management or building stock adaptation (priority on energy efficiency).

Need to integrate the life quality dimension.




Transferability, amplification: thematic projects and the governance projects
